Licence Appeal Tribunal (LAT) – The Licence Appeal Tribunal (LAT) is an independent agency established by the Ontario government which adjudicates applications and resolves disputes concerning compensation claims and licensing activities regulated by the provincial government, including those activities of delegated administrative authorities such as Tarion. Individuals who have experience with LAT and who have heard consumer appeals of Tarion decisions will have knowledge of the Ontario New Home Warranties Plan Act, will be familiar with the consumer claims appeals process, and may have familiarity with some Tarion processes. Builder Arbitration Forum (BAF) – The Builder Arbitration Forum is a process that involves an independent arbitrator which gives builders the opportunity to appeal the findings of a Tarion

assessment. Arbitrators who preside over BAF cases are not employees of Tarion, and they issue binding decisions where builders and Tarion have disputes (usually whether a decision Tarion has made in support of a consumer claim is correct or not). Arbitrators who have presided over BAF hearings will have knowledge of the Ontario New Home Warranties Plan Act, will be familiar with the claims appeals process, and may have familiarity with some Tarion processes as well as having some construction related experience. Consumer Advisory Council (CAC) – The Consumer Advisory Council acts as an advisory body to Tarion that provides ongoing advice specifically from a home buyer/consumer perspective on existing and proposed policies or any proposed changes impacting new home buyers.
